To the TVC

During the next OFSRDC meeting, Petrina Buchheit, co-chairman of the Silver City Square's competition squares, will be presenting a request to the dancers in Oregon for financial assistance for the Silver City Square's youth to attend the Pacific Northwest Teen Festival Competition in Auburn, WA. The Silver City Squares are the only youth from Oregon who will be attending the competition. They accept kids from all over the state to train with them and participate in the competition. Currently, they have kids from Albany, Jefferson, Scio, Stayton, Sublimity, Woodburn, Salem, Keizer, and Silverton. If there are any square dancing kids from this area who would like to train with the kids, they would be welcome.

This year, the Pacific Northwest Teen Festival (http://pntsdf.org/cms3/) will have youth dancers from the British Columbia, Alberta, Washington, Oregon and Alaska. This is the first competition they have had since things were closed due to Covid. Prior to that, the last 2 competitions were held in Silverton, Oregon with Karvn Buchheit (OFSRDC Youth Activities Coordinator) chairing the event. If you ever have an opportunity to attend a PNWTF, I hope you do so. Watching the kids square and round dance is exciting. They make it all look so beautiful and effortless. Not only will the kids be dancing at all levels of square dancing and round dancing, they will be calling and cueing, too. Karvn currently has 37 youth (ages 8-24) registered to attend this year's festival. Due to the festival being cancelled the last couple years, they are extending the age up to 24 this year only to allow students to participate who were unable to due to Covid. Their projected expenses are \$13,000. The Festival is on May 5-6, and they need our help. I would like to ask the TVC to consider holding a fundraiser dance for the kids on April 16, or some other date that works better for you. I am willing to work with VP Linda Curtis to organize the dance, promote the dance, request baskets, and organize the basket raffle during the dance if there is an interest in the TVC in hosting this dance. If there is, I'd like to ask for baskets from each club and individual dancers. If you are interested, I can try to see if any of the youth are available to attend our dance so we can dance with them and ask them to demonstrate some of their choreography. We can also ask them to take turns on the microphone if this is your desire.

Thank you for your consideration. Kathy

During the meeting, Linda Curtis proposed that the dance be held during the regular **TVC 5**th **Saturday dance** on April 29, at the Kinton Grange with all of the profits from the door and the basket raffle to be donated to the youth. The Kinton Grange, Terry Halley, and Julie Stiers have already received their contracts for this dance and will be paid according to their contracts. The membership agreed to Linda's proposal. Linda will discuss with the Executive Board next month about whether or not the TVC will pay for the caller, cuer, and hall separately so the youth would receive all of the income from the dance

The following is from Petrina and Benjamin's letter to the clubs of the OFSRDC. Please contact me if you would like to receive the entire letter:

"In order for our entire group to go, we have projected expenses of close to \$13,000. To date, we have raised \$3,300 (Summer Festival helped get us here) and are still working. Our advisors are working at getting our expenses to be less and have managed to get \$1,500 worth of donations of time and hall. We are also actively working on trying to get some business sponsorships, but that is still a work in progress. Our estimations on our expenses and incomes are at the end of this letter...
