TVC Recognition Award for 2023: The TVC presented the 2023 Recognition Award to Frank and Nadine Collett.

The Award recipients for 2023 danced together from the first time they dated. They took square dance lessons from the Tigard 59ers in the fall of 1979. They danced with the 59ers, which joined with the Merry C-Saws and the Robin Hoods in 1998 to form the Tri Squares. They were founding members and were instrumental in creating the name of the club. They have danced with the Tri Squares ever since. Sadly, Frank passed away in March, but we are assured that his family appreciated the honor and prestige of this recognition.

Frank and Nadine have supported the TVC and Tri Squares tirelessly. Frank was President and Vice President of the 59ers, and Frank and Nadine have served in many offices in Tri Squares. Frank was part of the Committee to create the By-Laws for the club, Nadine published a Club Roster every year until 2020. They are well known to the TVC because between them they served as Club Delegates to the TVC, both as 59ers and Tri Squares. Frank was the other Delegate when I became a Delegate. His encouragement was important to my own decision to step up and lead. Frank and Nadine have been avid square dancers and have attended many festivals including all of the Mid Winter Festivals from 1993 through 2019. They were volunteers and attended the 1994 National Square Dance Convention in Portland. They danced under the midnight sun in Fairbanks, Alaska in 1997, and they were known for taking their fifth-wheel camper all over to square dance festivals. Service as Officers is a sign of commitment to your Club and Council, and dancing in many venues is also commendable; however, this Award recognizes the much deeper involvement in sustaining the life of the Club and Council. Frank and Nadine were angels when Linda and I first took lessons in 2009; they were angels when we took round dance lessons. They taught us the joy of dancing with students and helping to make square dancing fun. As long as we have known them, they have been angels for both square and round dance lessons. They were angels right up to Frank's sudden passing in March. I would like to present this Award to Nadine.
