State Delegates report: (Dale Brabham)

The OFRDFC met on September 18. New officers were installed. Reports were made by Officers, committees, and Delegates.

A big thanks to Josie Rosenbury for preparing the TVC report to the State. Important items to note:

Mid-Winter Festival is on Jan. 27-29, 2023 in Albany. The next Federation meeting is there on Jan. 29. Detail about the Festival are available in the OFN.

The past Summer Festival broke even. There was a long report about why the attendance was low, where hurt feelings expressed about how callers and cuers were treated.

The Seaside Sashay and other festivals were announced and discussed. Details have already been provided by Ursula.

The results of the vote to change state terms of office came in favor of the change from one to two years. They voted to implement the change so that the change in officers is stagerred.

The leadership sequence of 1st VP, President, and Past President became problematic. We voted to keep this cycle with one year terms. The Parliamentarian indicated that the new wording allowed us to modify the length of terms as necessary,

I received insurance forms for each Oregon club in the TVC. These have been distributed to club Treasurers. Instructions are included with the forms. Please have your Treasurer update the forms and return with insurance check from your club made out to OFSRDC to me. I will forward them to the State Insurance Chair. I need them back by November 10. You have to update the club roster and list students, as well as, verify a correct insurance certificate. Please do not put this off.

I received State Directories according to how many were requested by each club. Most have been distributed. Each Club Treasurer should send a check for \$3.70 x number of copies to Tammy LeBlanc, the TVC treasurer. She is already remitting funds for these directories to the OFSRDC. I will remind Treasurers of this directly by email.

I thank the PAC for hosting a fine dinner and dance at the Maplewood Grange to kick off our meeting and provide recognition to the state leadership team. It is a lot of work and an inspiration for me when it is TVC's turn to sponsor this activity.
