EOM March checking balance: \$1,396.97 EOM March savings balance: \$4,993.80

#### March Activity:

\$100 deposited – Sunset Promenaders returned the host club split from the New Year's Eve dance plus \$13 to make a \$100 donation. Thanks, Promenaders!

After expenses were paid for the March dance, there was a \$282 profit, which was split with the Hoedowners, as host club: they received a check for \$141 and the TVC had a \$141 profit from the dance.
