Previous Council meeting minutes approved as written.

President's report: (Mike St. Clair)

We are presenting an Ambassador Badge to Robert Allen.

Special presentation: Julie Stiers brought Stephanie Foster of the Alzheimer's Association to speak about what the Association does, and what you can expect from her at the Alzheimer's Association benefit dance in May.

What does the Association do with the funds that it raises? 60 percent of the money that is raised in Oregon stays in Oregon. It goes to free education, training, care, support, and support groups for anyone in the area who has Alzheimer's or dementia, and anyone who is taking care of somebody who has this. We work with training first responders: police, fire, etc., so that they can recognize when someone they're approaching has Alzheimer's or dementia, and we give them tools to approach that person in a respectful and gentle way. We also train people at care facilities for how to run the support groups. We also have art and music programs. The rest goes to the our national Organization. We are the #1 non-profit funder of research around the world for for possible cures of Alzheimer's. We also have a help line. Anyone can call at any time with questions regarding Alzheimer's or dementia. More information will be on the flyer at the dance.
