What we learn very soon is that square dances do not happen by themselves. There is work to find callers, cuers, and venues. There is money collecting, bookkeeping and reporting. There is advertising and creating flyers. There is setup, hosting, and clean up of the dance. There are meetings, reports, and minutes. There is a lot to do. It takes work to create an environment for the joy of square dancing.

It is easy to get so involved that we lose the big picture and forget the joy that first attracted us. Sometimes clubs may be trying to do too much. Food and decorations really add a lot, but they should not control us. If the work is stressing your club members, maybe you could reduce pressure on yourselves and scale back a little. We want to be careful not to drive people away with too many duties.

During the Thanksgiving holidays I have reflected on how thankful I am for those who work so hard to make our TVC Club dances so great. I do see the joy that so many of you find in doing the work. Therefore, let us all help each other to find more joy not just in square dancing, but also in doing the work of making square dances happen.
