I am Tom Sminia, the new TVC Treasurer per your vote at the last meeting after Joanne resigned because of health issues.

I am distributing a printed financial report to you and I have enough copies for one to each club.

This last month has been a challenge to get this report put together. First Mike St. Clair and I worked with the bank at transferring the TVC bank account from and to, and then finding out what was needed to get up to date, correct some errors, and pay some bills, etc. Needless to say, it was stressful for an old man like me. As far as I know the fires are out and I am not so stressed now, and I am able to write checks and Mike is considered the owner of the TVC.

On August 31st the TVC had a fifth Saturday which was a good dance except few dancers (37) came. So there was no profit which meant the host of the dance does not get any profit share. The TVC did also lose a little money, \$33. Reasons for the loss could be the Labor Day holiday, or dancers not aware there was a dance, etc. Hopefully we won't have that happen again.

Over the year we have spent more money than we made and so we had to transfer money (\$1,000) from TVC savings to the TVC checking account. We have money but we are using up TVC money which is not a sustainable thing of course. Only the Government can print new money. Anyway let us work on having successful events in the future.

State Directories: The State Directories were handed out.

Insurance information: The OFSRDC insurance packets were distributed. Please check the lists of dancers in your clubs. Add the names of new members, and cross out any names that are no longer members. Names with asterisks are dancers who also belong to another club that is their primary club. Also, in these packets are your Certificates of Insurance. If your club no longer needs them, please write Delete on them. For now, cost: \$4.75/person with \$45.00 minimum per club; this may change later. Also, clubs in Washington are encouraged to get insurance in Oregon. Please complete and bring back this information to our October 28 Meeting.

Summer Festival 2019: Profits were shared for coordinating and registration at the Festival. The councils received checks of \$189.45 each.

Mid-Winter Festival 2020: You can now register and pay online. The Federation wanted to know how may program books the TVC needed. Darrell Kalmbach will bring 65 program books in November. The Education Session for January 25 will be on social media, including an introduction to Twitter and Instagram. Only 43 percent of the clubs are taking advantage of using social media for advertising.

OFN: Only two Councils have 100 percent participation in the OFN: Rogue-Sis-Q and the TVC. **Summer Festival 2020:** This will be held August 21-23 in Seaside. Callers will be Daryl Clendenin, Randy Dibble and Jim Hattrick. Cuers will be Dave and Patty Cooper.

Summer Festival 2021: Proposed for the 4th of July weekend at the Linn County Fairgrounds. It may be just Mainstream, Plus and rounds. Thu-Sat with State Meeting on Sunday. An issue was raised: An individual or couple of people wanted to put on the Summer Festival. According to the Federation, only a Federated club is allowed to sponsor the Festival. There was discussion about this.
