OR Federation Meeting was held on September 11. The old slate of Officers departed, and the new slate took over.

Melissa James (Columbia River Dancers, Bachelor 'n' Bachelorettes) has been named as the TVC Goodwill Ambassador for this year. She is also an up and coming Caller.

A Centenarian Award has been arranged to honor Paul and Dottie Swenson. It was hoped to be presented to Paul at his 100th birthday but it was not available yet.

It was mentioned that the Federation has a Sunshine person, Lorri McIntosh. If our Sunshine person is interested in perhaps letting Lorri be aware of our Sunshine items, Lorri would send Sunshine wishes on behalf of the Federation. She will be changing her e-mail address soon.

The Federation has donated \$1,000 to the USDA Scholarship Program this year. Petrina Buchheit received \$1,000 from the Federation and from the USDA. The certificates were presented at the Federation dance.

Josie reminded us that it is the individual club's responsibility to be sure that their caller and cuer are current with their BMI, ASCAP and SESAC licenses. Clubs can be subject to a fine if the licenses are not current.

There is a new IRS form (1099-NEC) for callers making in excess of \$600 a year. This form should be used instead of Form 1099-MISC when the caller and cuer get Non Employee Compensation from the Club.

Summer Festival 2022 will be held at Blanchet Catholic School in Salem on July 15, 16 and 17. We were reminded that cowboy boots are not allowed on the floor. The Interstate Highlanders and Rogue Sis-Q Councils have volunteered to co-host this event.

Mid-Winter Festival 2023 is scheduled for January 27, 28 and 29 in Albany.
