September Activity

There were 78 dancers in attendance at the 9/14/24 dinner and dance to host the State Federation. Hoedowners won the TVC banner for the club with the highest percentage in attendance, at 41%. Valley Squares were close behind with 40% attendance. There were two dancers from High Desert Dancers in Bend who won the longest distance travel. Donations for the dinner covered all but \$8 of the cost of the food. Thank you to everyone who contributed. A check for \$85.04 was given to Tri-Squares as the host club, which is a 50% split of profit from the dance.

\$200 was paid to R Square D as reimbursement for lesson advertisement expenses. A very nice thank you note was received from Sandy Sims, their VP, with a sample of the business cards they had printed. This exhausts the budgeted money for lesson advertisement reimbursement to clubs. Additional requests received in this fiscal year will need to be voted on by the Council.

\$115 was paid for the new TVC Directories, and \$45.98 was paid for a 2-year domain renewal. \$20 was paid for rental of Aloha Grange for our September TVC meeting

\$25 was paid for additional supplies for the State Dance.

New Business:

Insurance Coverage: Washington TVC members as members of "Oregon" TVC club for insurance: Would it be feasible if any member of a TVC club in Washington joined a TVC club in Oregon to receive better insurance coverage for those members?

Some details: Washington's secondary insurance is different from Oregon's. It covers them from door-to-door to attend a dance event in Washington. If Washington residents come to a dance in Oregon, they are not covered by insurance. Oregon's insurance is better in that regard, because Oregon's insurance covers Oregon club members in Oregon or Washington, if we attend a dance event, or while we are at a dance event. Oregon's coverage is not as good as Washington's, but it covers more states. Oregon's insurance covers all of the USDA states, while Washington's insurance covers only members in Washington. Some of the Washington dancers come down to attend events in Oregon, but they are not insured there if they are not a member of a USDA club.

Discussion. Item tabled. Delegates, please take this back to your Clubs and report back to the TVC.

TVC e-mail lists: There has been a problem with many TVC Officers and Delegates not receiving emails through our two e-mail lists from other TVC Officers and Delegates. The TVC has those two email lists created by Tim Roberts; however, we have no idea about who is on those lists. We need to find out who is on these lists so that they can be updated. In the meantime, a new e-mail list has been created by Joann. Question: Is it good for the TVC to continue using our own (Joann's) list for e-mails, or go through the two existing e-mail lists created by Tim Roberts?

Discussion. Andis will send the Minutes to Joann, then she will send them to all of the rest of the TVC Officers and Delegates.

Decision was made to continue using the two lists by Tim Roberts. For now, we will also use Joann's list.

Further discussion. An Executive Board meeting has been called to resolve this issue.
